Parks and Recreation:

1. Selectman Bill Connolly to discuss a proposed warrant article for Annual Town

Meeting to have the Parks & Recreation Commission take over responsibility for

Fuller Field - Board of Selectman put an article on warrant to seek legislative

authorization to transfer the responsibility of Fuller Field to the CP&R. It has been

under discussion for years. The Board of Selectman is the appointing authority

for the Fuller Field Commission. There was a reestablishment of the terms of

- appointed boards by the Board of Selectmen. This included implementing a change in the Fuller Field commission to appoint board members from Parks and Recreation. This will not happen for another 2 years after being passed. The term would be consistent with the term of the sitting members of the parks and recreation initially. The Fuller Field commission would be a 5 person board.
- 2. CP&R Department Updates Selectmen have a new green issue to reduce paper wastes. The building is now open to the public, but will be closed to the public during youth programs. People will be served by appointment to reduce crowding. Playgrounds are open with social distancing and mask requirements. They are being sanitized daily. Programs being offered are limited to groups of 10 with 2 adults with social distancing and masks as well as sanitization of equipment.
- 3. New and Old Business/Open Discussion Yoanna thanks Maya Pagoaga for her time with the department. Matt mentions the Musco cost savings would be approximately \$7,000 if they did both fields at Savage Field at the same time rather than each field on separate days.
