Fuller Field:

1. Fuller Field Transition Update from Selectmen Kobus & Connolly

"Transition members Kobus and Connelly briefed the board on ongoing concerns with the Fuller Field facilities and outlined the activities and profiled end user groups that use the facilities. Handout provided.

Priority Concerns:

Water Main Issue. Poor access to main valve highlighted. Replacement needed. Estimate is in file. Suggested an advocacy campaign to get budget approval.

Securing Field House and Storage Area Issue.

Field Condition Issue: Restoring previous maintenance routine recommended.

Discussion was made about submitting a request for Water Main Valve Project to be included in the next round of budget planning. Follow up is needed as the budget season begins in Feb.

Member Kobus highlighted the valuable resource of end user volunteers. Member Garofoli asked about considering formalizing that resource by exploring forming subcommittees for the various field uses.

Member Connelly highlighted that subcommittees were very useful in aiding other committees.

Member Connelly advised that the commission prepare for annual budget during FY 20 as a guide.

Public Comment: Yoanna Osborne asked about status of promoting Fuller Field as a Historic Site. Member Kobus updated that no new information was available and stressed it was still a goal.

Director Karit advised test she would coordinate with the Budget process to include relevant Fuller requests.
