## Plans from the Little League to make improvements to Save Field Little League Field

- o Have meeting with Little League on 9/28/16 to review goals
- Two co-presidents (Matt Varakis & Matt Kobis)
- They have received grant dollars and want to make improvements
- Goals: windscreen (needs to have CPR logo and be black), warning lane (spray to kill grass, most cost effective, done twice a year), safety on foul balls onto Water Street (B&B fencing increase to 8ft will be replaced with black fencing on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> baseside), add gates to dugouts
- Scoreboard needs to be up and operational

## Safety improvements to Little League Field funded by CPR (cost offset by Little League)

- o safety on foul balls onto Water Street (B&B fencing increase to 8ft will be replaced with black **fencing** on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> base side), add gates to dugouts
- bleachers need to be reconstructed
  - o 4-tier \$2100
  - o 5-tier \$4000
