Summer Playground Counselor (Multiple Positions Available)

Playground Counselors provide supervision and instruction to summer playground participants in a variety of activities in a fun and safe environment.

Hours: Monday- Friday, Up to 30 hours, Shifts vary: **7- 2 pm, 8:30-3:30 or 9:30 -4:30 pm**

Dates of Program: June 17 - August 23 (No July 4, 5)

Reports to the Director of Parks & Recreation and works under the general supervision of the Camp Director

Pay: \$15.00-15.55 per hour

Essential Job Duties

- Being responsible for the location and safety of children assigned to you/your group 100% of the time.
- Keeping head counts of the children assigned to your group
- Following directions and schedule of activities
- Ensure a safe environment during all activities
- Setup and breakdown of activities and supplies
- Being a positive role model for the participants in the program
- Engaging with the group of children in each activity.
- Able to communicate with other staff and parents as needed
- Handling conflicts of children in your group
- Supervise children in the swimming pool and follow the instructions of lifeguards.
- Supervise children on bus and off site for field trips.

Qualifications

- Experience working with school-age children
- Must be aged 16 or aged 15 with experience of two full summers in a CIT Program
- CPR/First Aid certificate or the ability to become trained (training provided)

Abilities

Employees are required to walk, stand, sit, speak, hear, and use their hands to operate various sports equipment and/or craft supplies. Work is performed on athletics fields, pools, schools, playgrounds, gym floors, beaches, etc. Candidates must be able to work inside and outside with exposure to various weather conditions.
